

The University of Vienna invites applications for a

Professorship in e-Education

This dual professorship applies to both the Faculty of Psychology and to the Faculty of Computer Science. The appointment is a full-time, permanent position under private law.

The successful applicant shall have:

1. a degree in Psychology and in Computer Science from an Austrian university or the equivalent from a foreign university and/or a demonstrable background in both disciplines
2. outstanding qualifications in research and teaching within both disciplines
3. pedagogical and didactic ability
4. evidence of academic leadership
5. relevant international experience within his/her area of expertise

The professorship will be instituted at the interface between Computer Science and Psychology. Applicants are expected to have a proven record of publications as well as a proven ability of attracting substantial research funding within the field of e-Teaching and e-Learning. He/she will also realise models of psychological learning and motivation and take into account different approaches of IT and Communication Technology that optimise the further development of teaching and learning processes. The successful applicant will be expected to contribute to the projects Life Long Learning and Lab Educational Technologies, conducted by the Faculty of Psychology and the Faculty of Computer Science respectively. Additionally, he/she should be able to co-operate in an interdisciplinary manner and this should be proven with relevant publications. The applicant is expected to contribute to enhancing the various courses on offer in both faculties and to teach within his/her field of expertise. The faculties are notably keen on promoting the use of new media for instructional purposes in teaching.

Written applications should include:

- curriculum vitae
- list of publication record
- the names of at least three referees
- short description of research interest within the field of e-Education
- record of selected publications together with appropriate link(s) for download

Applications should be submitted to the human resources department of the University of Vienna, Dr.-Karl-Lueger-Ring 1, 1010 Vienna, Austria, for the attention of Ms. Frank, quoting the reference number E-EDU/2005. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted to send a list of their publications.
