Please respond to this Call for *Research*, *Practice*, *or Advocacy Proposals* to present at the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual World Congress on Learning Disabilities, November 1-3, 2007 in Marlborough, MA (USA). The roster of local, national and international presenters needs you. Over 60 sessions will include researchers, teachers, related service providers, administrators, parents and advocates. These skilled individuals will provide the latest information on theory, practices and policy for students and adults with LD. You are invited to be among those presenters.

Last year's keynote presenters included Drs. Albert Galaburda, Don Deshler and Mark Cooper, and over 60 others, from more than 20 countries. Over 700 people attended, and closer to 1,000 are expected this year.

To submit a research, practice, or advocacy proposal to present at the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual World Congress on Learning Disabilities, please follow the guidelines from this announcement. If you have already submitted a proposal for the research symposia, please ignore this announcement. Currently, the two program chairs of last year are working on editing a volume of proceedings from the 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Congress. We expect that we will publish a volume of proceedings from the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual World Congress on Learning Disabilities as well. This compilation of works will involve the research presentations and the works will go through a review process prior to being included in the proceedings.

#### Abstracts for symposia (90 minutes) must include:

All individual presentations (see above)

A short description (max. 250 words) of the aims and the scope of the symposium.


