Registrants wanting overnight accommodation are urged to register early. Conference delegates are allocated their first choice in accommodation on a first come first serve basis. We have rooms on hold at two locations:

Manchester Business School costs £55/night, breakfast included. Accommodation is located at conference site and is a 5 minute walk to conference dinner.

Weston Hall costs £42/night, breakfast included (at next door Manchester Conference Center). Accommodation is off-site and is a 5 minute walk from Manchester Piccadilly rail station and about a 15-20 minute walk to conference site. Reasonable transportation will be provided to conference site and conference dinner for delegates staying at Weston Hall.
