constraints make an even greater variety of qualitatively distinct messages and relationships impossible or unimaginable in the system AS IT STANDS.

A code is thus of a HIGHER LOGICAL TYPE (and therefore less complet) than its messages and messengers. Deep-structure socioeconomic revolution – as distinct from surface-structure change mediated by the given codes – provides an example of the reordering or restructuring of the dominant socioeconomic codes that make one kind of society qualitatively distinct from others. This kind of restructuring nevertheless takes place within the context of codes and constraints – e.g., inorganic and organic (ecological) constraints; the constraints of social organization as such; the requirements of metabolism, maintenance, and subsistence; the genetic code; and so on – none of which appears to have changed in any significant way since the evolution of society.

In human affairs, the structure of the code-message and the codemessenger relation can in part be represented by a version of the Hegelian and Marxian 'triangle of mediation', as in *Figure 1*. The use of solid and broken lines in this diagram is intended to serve as a reminder that the relation involves a hierarchy of logical types.
